## MPP BATTERY POWERED WATER PUMP

### INSTRUCTIONS:

The US Saws Meter Pit Pump (MPP) is designed to remove standing water from meter boxes, valve boxes and other subterranean boxes where standing water is a problem.

1. Attach the appropriate battery to the handle of the pump. (Follow the battery manufacturers instructions for proper use and care of the battery)
2. Hold the discharge hose and aim it in the area where the water can be displaced safely
3. Submerge the pump wand into the liquid and turn the switch on.
4. When the pumping is complete, keep the switch "On" and remove the pump wand. Shut the switch "Off" when the pump wand is over the discharge area to let the excess water drain out.

### SAFETY:

DO NOT use the MPP where electrical current is present.

DO NOT use the MPP for any FLAMABLE LIQUID.

DO NOT run the MPP dry for more than 30 seconds. The motor is cooled by the water passing over it.

DO NOT submerge the handle, switch, or battery.

### CARING FOR YOUR MPP:

It is good practice to flush the pump with clean, fresh water after use. This will prevent buildup of mud, algae, sand.

Store the MPP in an upright position to let all water drain out the bottom.

Always use the debris screen. Removing the debris screen can result in a damaged impeller.

The MPP is equipped to pump muddy water but it is not designed to pump mud.

**Please understand that this product has limitations. It should also not be used as a "battering ram" to break up solid debris/ice.**
