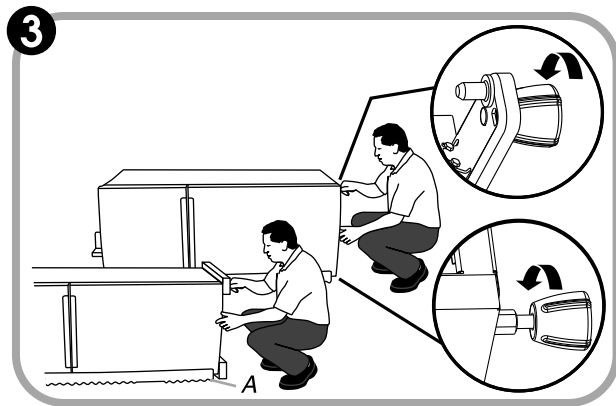
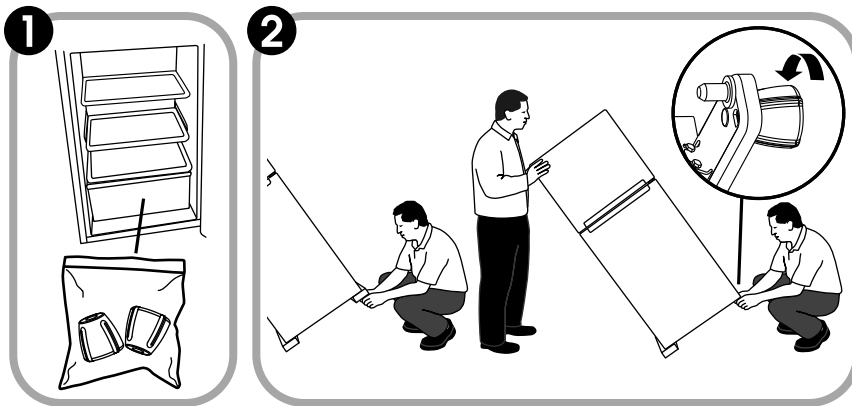


# Install Levelers



**IMPORTANT:** Lay down the refrigerator **ONLY** to your left-hand side (as you are looking at the front of the refrigerator), to avoid damaging the refrigerator.

- 1 Locate the levelers. They are enclosed in a plastic bag inside the crisper drawer.

## **⚠ WARNING**

### **Excessive Weight Hazard**

**Use two or more people to move and install refrigerator.**

**Failure to do so can result in back or other injury.**

**IMPORTANT:** Using two or more people, access the bottom of the refrigerator either by tilting it first to one side and then the other, **OR** by laying it down on the floor to your left-hand side, as shown.

- 2 Tilt the refrigerator to the side enough to access the bottom. Using a  $\frac{3}{8}$ " hex head nut driver, remove the two screws attaching the wooden runner to the bottom of the refrigerator. Then, install a leveler to the front corner. Repeat for the opposite side.

**NOTE:** The refrigerator cabinet should not touch the floor without having a leveler installed.

**OR**

- 3 Using the packaging corner posts (A) (left-hand side, front and back) as a cushion, lay the refrigerator down on the floor (to your left-hand side only). Using a  $\frac{3}{8}$ " hex head nut driver, remove the two screws attaching each wooden runner to the bottom of the refrigerator. Install a leveler to each of the front corners.
