

Install Levelers





IMPORTANT: Lay down the refrigerator ONLY to your left-hand side (as you are looking at the front of the refrigerator), to avoid damaging the refrigerator.

Locate the levelers. They are enclosed in a plastic bag inside the crisper drawer.

AWARNING

Excessive Weight Hazard

Use two or more people to move and install refrigerator. Failure to do so can result in back or other injury.

IMPORTANT: Using two or more people, access the bottom of the refrigerator either by tilting it first to one side and then the other, OR by laying it down on the floor to your left-hand side, as shown.

2 Tilt the refrigerator to the side enough to access the bottom. Using a %" hex head nut driver, remove the two screws attaching the wooden runner to the bottom of the refrigerator. Then, install a leveler to the front corner. Repeat for the opposite side.

NOTE: The refrigerator cabinet should not touch the floor without having a leveler installed.

OR

3 Using the packaging corner posts (A) (left-hand side, front and back) as a cushion, lay the refrigerator down on the floor (to your left-hand side only). Using a ¾" hex head nut driver, remove the two screws attaching each wooden runner to the bottom of the refrigerator. Install a leveler to each of the front corners.
