



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
ZA383 Spare Parts



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Screw the floor pillar legs to the inlet water connections: make sure that these are G. 1/2" male threaded and keep them at a range of 5"29/32 (see fig.1).

Put the base (1) on the leg and the cut bushing (2) inside the base; mark the holes position (see fig.2).

Make a hole using a 013/32 drill, put the dowels (3) and fix the base (1) to the floor by means of the appropriate screws (4) using a 5/32" wrench (see fig.3).

Insert the cut bushing (2) and the threaded ring (5) tighten it with a 1"7/16 wrench (see fig.3).

Insert the little bushing shafts (6) in the drilled sleeve (7) and assemble everything on the pillar legs (see fig.4). Screw the clamp (8) to the rod (9) and put this last one in to middle sleeve (7) (see fig.4).

Use the clamp to anchor the frame to the overflow pipe of the bath drain (two clamps are supplied in different sizes to match the pipe diameter).

Once found the ideal position for fixing, tightly screw all dowels with a 3/32" wrench (see fig.4).

Screw the little curves (10) on the legs with a 1"3/16 wrench (see fig.5).

Assemble the bath mixer on the legs screwing the caps with a 1"3/16. wrench (see fig.5).
