



INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

PARTS:

- A Lever handle (Pre-Installed)
- B Complete Flush Valve (Pre-Installed)
- C Complete Fill Valve with Float (Pre-Installed)
- D Toilet Seat
- E Mounting Bracket Kit
- F Rubber Bolt Washer
- G Metal Washers
- H Tank Bolts
- I Metal Nuts
- J Rubber Gasket







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REMOVING YOUR OLD TOILET

1 2	Turn off the water supply. Flush the toilet to empty the tank. Remove any water left in the tank or bowl.

_	Disconnect the supply line from tank.		
4	Remove decorative caps. Unscrew nuts that attach the toilet to the floor.	FIG 2	
5	Remove toilet.	E	(E)
INST/	ALLATION PROCEDURE		
1	Make sure the water supply valve is shut off before installation.		
2	Remove old closet bolts from closet flange. Clean any old wax, putty, etc. from base area.		
3	Attach white mounting brackets (E) to the flange bolts. Use the washer and bolt to secure. (See Figure 1)		
4	Install the bracket (E) onto the flange by inserting the bolt into the large part of the slot. Slide the bracket down the slot to the smaller end and tighten the bolt. (See Figure 2)

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INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

Insert tank bolts (H) inside the tank. Use rubber washers (F) supplied to create a seal. (See Figure 3)

Attach the large rubber sealing gasket (J) to the center drain hole under the tank. (See Figure 3)

Gently place the tank on the bowl with the bolts (H) protruding out underneath. Then tighten with metal washers (G) and metal nuts (I), tighten enough that the tank sits flat on the bowl.

Turn the toilet side ways onto a soft surface to avoid scratches on the finish. Place a new wax ring (not included) around the waste flange of the toilet bowl. (See Figure 4)



Lower the toilet into position so that the bracket are parallel to the inner wall of the toilet. (See Figure 5) Using a rocking motion, press the bowl down to position the toilet onto the flange and create a seal with the wax ring.

Insert screw through the mounting hole on the side of the toilet and tighten until it catches



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
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Attach the decorative screwhead covers on each side of the bowl.

the mounting bracket holes. (See Figure 6) **CAUTION: DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.**



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TOILET SEAT INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

Align the toilet seat to the top rim of the toilet bowl. (See Figure 8)


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
Use a screwdriver to firmly tighten both seat bolts down to the bowl. (See Figure 9)


Place the toilet seat on top of the bowl and then insert the provided seat bolt sets into

Push the decorative caps down over the bolts. (See Figure 10)


CAUTION: Do not push down on the seat with force, doing so may damage the slow close mechanism.
















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CONNECT WATER SUPPLY

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Connect water supply line (new or existing) between shutoff valve and tank inlet water fitting. Tighten coupling nuts securely. **NOTE: DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN**

Turn on supply valve and allow tank to fill until float rises to shutoff position.

Check for leakage at fittings, tighten or correct as needed.

TROUBLE SHOOTING FOR REGULAR FLUSH VALVE OR CANISTER FLUSH VALVE

Problem: Poor Flush.

Solution: You need to verify if the chain is too long causing the flapper to not activate the flush properly.

Problem: Continuous water running.

Solution: It may occur if the flush valve seal is not completely closed. 1) Verify if there is any obstruction with the flush seal. 2) Make sure the flush valve chain has the proper length at rest.

Wipe the outside of the toilet gently with a damp cloth and blot dry with a soft towel. Make sure that the complete surface is cleaned and completely dry. NOTE: IMPROPER CARE MAY CAUSE THE WARRANTY TO BECOME INVALID.
